Dear Ridleian,

I would like to invite you to the fourth **Moule Day**, which will take place on the afternoon of **Wednesday 15th June 2011**. As usual, spouses are warmly invited to attend too. Please arrive from 2.00pm, when there will be a chance to socialise with old friends and the current Ridley community. The ensuing programme will include worship and an opportunity to find out more about Ridley's future direction. Tea will follow prior to the lecture itself, which will begin at 5.00pm, and should end no later than 6.30pm.

As you know, the C.F.D. Moule Memorial Lecture was established in 2008 in honour of Charlie Moule, who championed Ridley throughout his distinguished life. This year's lecture will be marking the 400th Anniversary of the King James Bible.

The C.F.D. Moule Lecturer this year is **Dr Andrew Walls**, Professor of the History of Mission at Liverpool Hope University and founder of the Centre for the Study of Christianity in the Non-Western World, at the University of Edinburgh. The title of his address will be **'Bible translation, local context and world mission'**. Dr Walls is one of the outstanding missionary thinkers of our time, whose seminal works include *The Missionary Movement in Christian History* (1996), and *The Cross-Cultural Process in Christian History* (2002). Church historian, Mark Noll, says of him that 'no one has written with greater wisdom about what it means for the Western Christian religion to become the global Christian religion'.

For your information, prior to your arrival, there will be a special morning programme for those who trained at Ridley between 1961–1970, which will include a visit to the University Library's exhibition on the making of the King James Bible.

Parking in Cambridge is always challenging, so we would encourage you to leave your car at one of the Park and Rides. See www.ridley.cam.ac.uk/map.html for further information.
